

>>>> Drip irrigation </</td>

Israel has suffered from a chronic water shortage. In order to save water, a new watering system was invented in Israel – the drip irrigation system, made of a watering device connected to a tap that releases water in a slow drip. The system transfers water in long tubes and releases it in a slow drip near the plant.





>>>Cherry Tomatoes <<<

The cherry tomato is a type of small round tomato popular mainly as a snack, in salads, and for the preparation of sauces. The taste of cherry tomatoes is similar to that of larger tomatoes and they are usually sweeter.





>>>> Insect free </</td>

Insect-free vegetables (also known as worm-free vegetables or Gush Katif vegetables) are vegetables (especially lettuce, parsley, coriander, etc.), grown and packaged for kashrut reasons in order to reduce the amount of insects in them.





>>>> New mango varieties </

In recent years, four new mango varieties have been developed, having a great success in Israel and around the world. The new mangoes are larger, of better quality and have a special color.





>>>> Wheat varieties <<<</td>for wholemeal flour

In Israel, species of wheat have been developed for whole flour, able to grow even in difficult places. They reached very high scores on taste tests around the world.

The State of Israel encourages people to take their herds to pasture in order to prevent fires. The pasture thins the weeds and creates weed-free plots so that the fire does not spread.
