

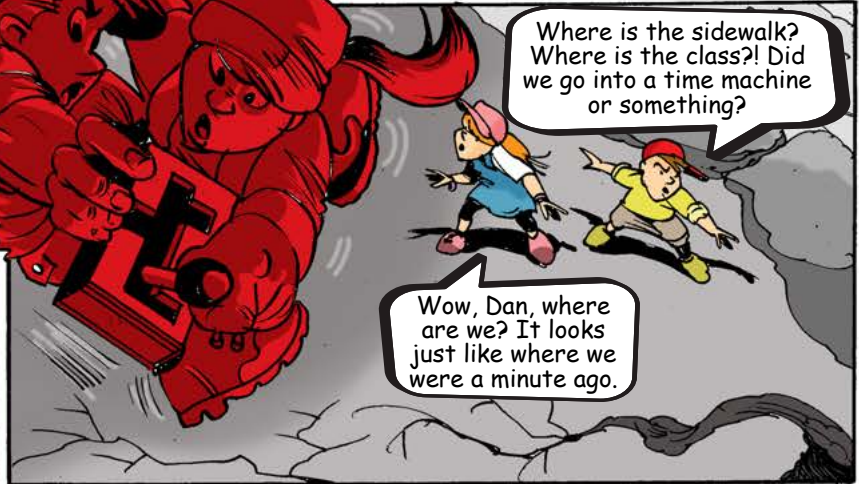
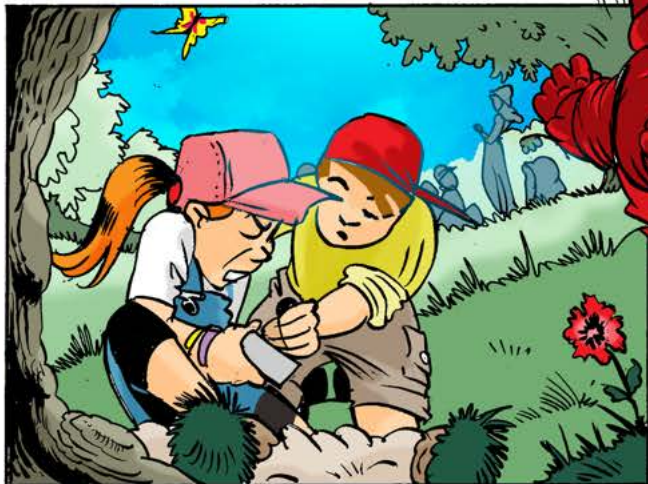
# An adventure in Jerusalem

Wow, Gili, look at this



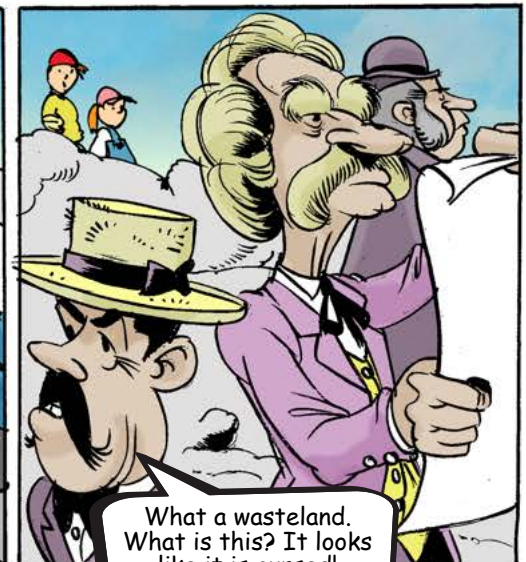
Where is the sidewalk? Where is the class?! Did we go into a time machine or something?

Wow, Dan, where are we? It looks just like where we were a minute ago.

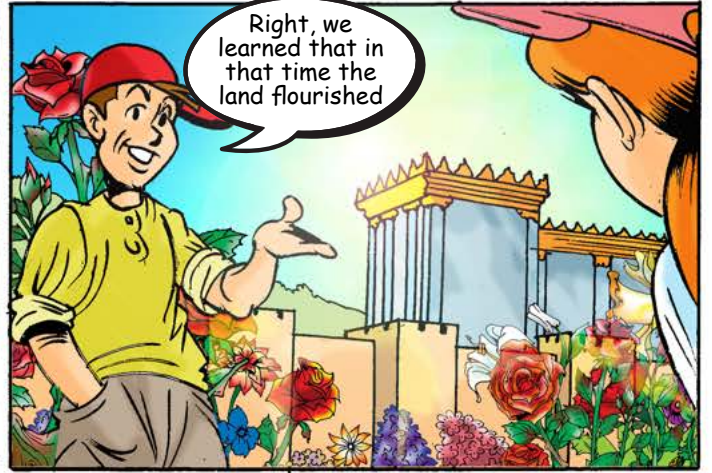


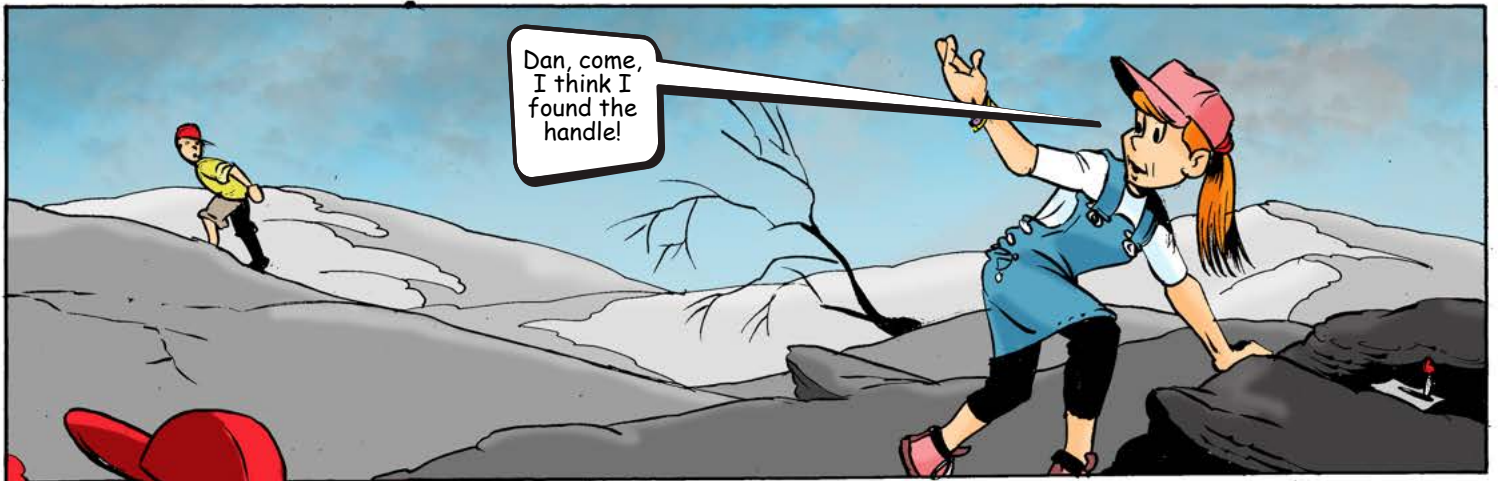
What is this?

Dan, come, I think I found the handle!



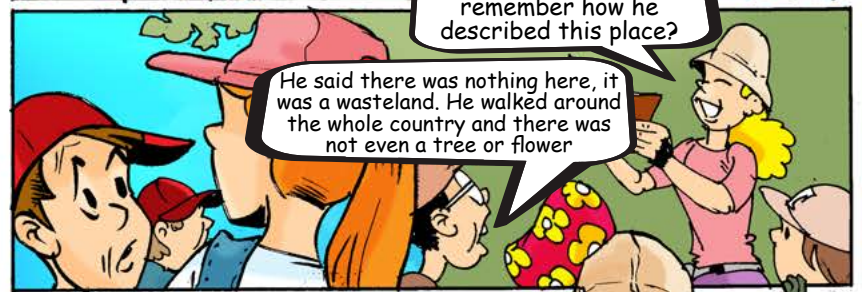
Dan, Gili, where have you been? We looked for you everywhere! Were you swallowed by the ground?!
