A vehicle system that includes only one camera and alerts the driver in real time about variety of collision hazards, deviates the vehicle from its traffic lane, detects pedestrians, cyclists and motorcycles, and detects speed signs. These functions serve as a kind of "third eye" for the driver, reduce the chance of road accidents and are the basis for the development of autonomous vehicles.
