The Temple Menorah





Tu B'Shvat is a festival celebrated in the middle of the Hebrew month of Shvat.



On **Tu B'Shvat**, it is customary to eat the Seven Species.





















My fruit is red. I have a hrd shell.

I have juicy kernels hidden inside of me. It is customary to eat me on Rosh Hashanah.

















My fruits are small and green. They can be used to produce a very healthy edible oil. That oil was also used to light the Menorah's fire in the Temple.

















The central branch of my tree is used as a Lulav on the festival of Sukkot. My fruit is very sweet and, when dried, can keep for a long time.

















My fruit is sweet and juicy, green or purple. You can dry my fruits, and they can be preserved for a long time. The leaves of my tree are very large and covered Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden.

















My fruits are small and juicy and can be used to make wine which is blessed with a special blessing at Kiddush on Shabbat and festivals.

















I grow in the field and have small, hard grains. You can grind these grains into flour and use the flour to make bread and cakes.

















I am a kind of grain that grows in the field. You can make flour from my grains and use the flour to make baked goods. My flour is less expensive than my friend, wheat, but my grains can also be used to make beer and other drinks.
